*NHM* follows *Nestle-Aland* Greek corrected (as documented) directly from:

- A. earliest extant complete mss. (4<sup>th</sup> century): Sinaiticus (א) and Vaticanus (β) Codices, Latin a-3 and the *Peshitêta* (corrupted to *Peshitta*);
- B. ALL extant source documents prior to c. 400 C.E., including papyri fragments from c. 200 C.E.<sup>1.0.7</sup>
- C. the earliest extant Hebrew mss. (dates of mss. preferred over theorized dates of composition) –
  - 1st. Quotes from 5<sup>th</sup> century *Talmud*; 9<sup>th</sup> century *Book of Nestor*, *Yaaqôv Bêh-Ruvein*'s מלחמות ה' (*Milkhâmôt* ה', Wars of 'ה'), 1170; 12<sup>th</sup> century Hebrew Ms. Or. Rome #53; 13<sup>th</sup> century ספר יוסף המקנא (*Seiphêr Yôseiph ha-Meqanei*, “the Zealous”) and ספר נצחון ישן (*Seiphêr Nitzâkhôn Yâshân*, “Book of Old Victory”);<sup>5.17.0</sup>
  - 2nd. שם טוב בן-יצחק בן-שפרוט (*Sheim-Tôv Bêh-Yitzkhâq Bêh-Shaprut*), c. 1380 (earliest extant mss. from 15<sup>th</sup> century).
